

Navarre Krewe of Jesters

History:

- ❖ Founded in 1986 by Burt Johnson & Ken Leveque Jr. at the Navarre Orleans restaurant at Navarre Beach, Florida. The Krewe has grown from the initial 10 members with a parade of walkers and a few floats, to over 80 members and more that 60 parade entries from Okaloosa, Escambia, and Santa Rosa counties!
- ❖ Originally called the “Krewe of Jesters”, we officially became the “Navarre Krewe of Jesters “ in 2000 in order to not be confused with the all female Krewe of Jesters in Pensacola.

Navarre Parade:

- ❖ This annual community event takes place on Saturdays right around Ash Wednesday with businesses and organizations from as far away as Central Alabama competing for the “Best Float” title! With over 30,000 spectators lined up to catch some beads! We are known for the best throws and the family friendly atmosphere that is not found anywhere else!

✓ Hospitality / Royalty Committee

At your service committee! Introduce Jester Royalty at parties and balls and welcome visiting dignitaries! Procure vehicles and present in grand fashion Jester Royalty in the Navarre Parade! Help maintain Royalty robes, crowns and terra's!

✓ Scholarship Committee

Help select the brightest star among many! Introduce the Navarre High School scholarship winner at a Krewe meeting! And present the recipient the scholarship award at the Annual Awards Banquet the night before graduation! Truly an honor!

✓ Public Relations Committee

Jesters is the Word! Make sure print and media are kept abreast of all things Jesters! From the Parade dates, to the scholarship winners, to the Jesters Duck Derby! Come one, come all! Come join in the fun!!

✓ Community Service Committee

Keep Jesters involved! Help coordinate community events such as the Annual Navarre Beach Road clean up, or the Jester tent in the Navarre Annual Relay for Life!

✓ Beads & Baubles

Here's the bling! Help keep the Krewe in style by choosing (or designing!) Jester pins and beads. No salesmanship needed to sell these items as the Krewe lines up whenever new ones are available.

✓ Website Design

New to the committee roster, this important committee shows the world the Jester Spirit!

✓ Policy & Procedures Committee

Help maintain Krewe policies so that everyone has a great time but follows the guidelines set forth by our forefathers... Initiate change as needed.

New to the Krewe...

Meetings:

❖ Meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month at a pre-determined location at 7 PM. Jester T-shirts and beads abound all year long (but aren't a necessity to attend meetings). Nametags are highly encouraged!

Required Krewe attire:

❖ Tuxedo Jacket with tails (Tuxedo shirt is acceptable but not required)
❖ Wearing of Beads, baubles, and all things Mardi Gras (clean only)!

Special Items Available:

❖ Krewe Beads & Pins are available at most Jester meetings. Trading Krewe Pins is a great way to meet new people and socialize with other Krewes before each parade! And unique Krewe beads are coveted by everyone!

Parade Requirements:

❖ Throwbeads – members are responsible to provide their own beads, dispersing at will. It is suggested 1 to 3 cases per parade.
❖ Learn – “Laissez Les Bons Temps Rouler”, meaning “Let the good times Roll!”

Float Protocol:

❖ Positions on the float will be assigned at the meeting prior to the event. Late arrivals and members who missed the meeting will be on a first come first serve basis.

Safety:

❖ Walkers: 6 safety walkers required in most parades to ensure pedestrians stay back from the floats. Walkers may be volunteers or members and are not required to have beads.
❖ Glass: Not allowed on the float during parades.
❖ Adult beverages: Discretely contained, spill proof cups/containers are suggested.
❖ Inebriated: Individuals that are too inebriated will not be allowed to ride on the float.
